## Golisano gives \$3.5 million for Niagara Falls health center

Niagara Falls Memorial Medical Center has received a \$3.5 million gift, the largest in its history, from businessman and philanthropist Tom Golisano to support construction of the new Golisano Center for Community Health.

The Center will provide comprehensive integrated health care services to adults with special needs and their families. It is believed to be one of the few centers of its kind in the country.

The Center will house a range of services and programs including primary care, mental health, Health Home care management, housing assistance, community outreach, satellite services, social services, health insurance enrollment, financial assistance counseling, wellness education and the training of healthcare professionals. The Child Advocacy Center of Niagara and Project Runway also will be located there.

Construction on the two-story 23,000-square-foot building is expected to begin in March 2015 and be completed by year's end.
